
Finolex and MMF reach out to kids

Pune: Children living with cerebral palsy in Satara will have better medical facilities with Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation (MMF) jointly starting physiotherapy sessions.

Though the Zilla Parishad here has facilities for these children, the two partners are aiming at strengthening the existing facilities in partnership with Sancheti Hospital. The hospital's specialised doctors will be

travelling to the neighbouring district once a week. In all, 19 children were benefitted on the inaugural day of the camp.

"There will be more centres, the next being in Phaltan. There are also special speech therapy sessions at the Wai centre which we plan to replicate at Satara," said Ritu Chhabria of Mukul Foundation.

The company also plans to set up taluka level rehabilitation centres in all districts, having travelled to far and remote villages.
