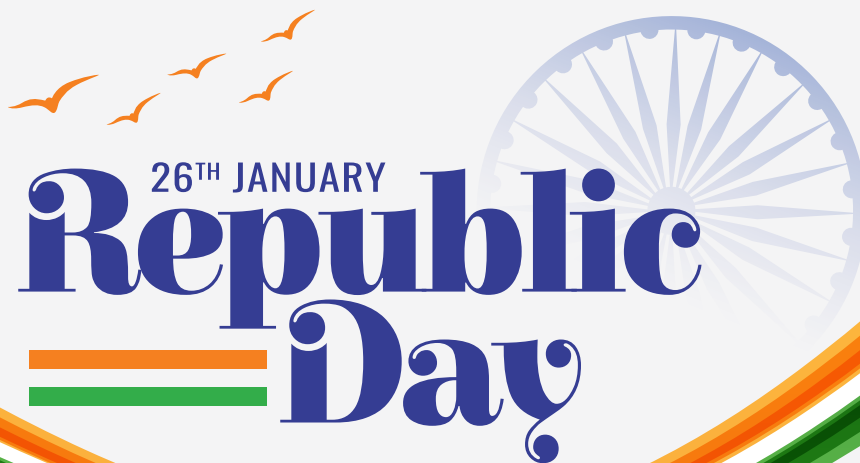
## MMF updates in Education for January
