- **Sandwich Making (23rd November 2024) for Grade 1 students, teaching healthy eating habits.**

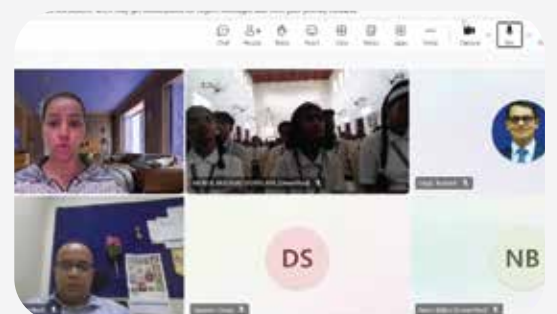
- **Peanut Laddoo Making (30th November 2024) for Grade 4 students, introducing them to traditional recipes and the joy of self-sufficiency.**
