IMPACT ASSESSMENT

COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS TO SUPPORT 10000 PEOPLE AFFECTED BY ASSAM FLOODS

Hinduja Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited have embarked on yet another relief work to support 10000 individuals in Morigoan and Barpeta villages in Assam. Mukul Madhav Foundation is supporting the relief work on ground with the help of volunteers, Finolex dealers and representatives. The relief work has been carried out across EIGHT heavily affected villages by distributing dry grocery comprising of Rice, Masoor Dal, Moong Dal, Salt, Sugar, Mustard Oil, Suji, Biscuits, turmeric, and face masks.



103 CEREBRAL PALSY CHILDREN SUPPORTED WITH TELEMEDICINE AID

Children with Cerebral Palsy (CP) require continuous care, both paramedical and medical. Due to pandemic it was nearly impossible for them to receive in-person Physiotherapy & Counseling on a daily basis. FIL/MMF has supported these patients through tele-medicine methodology, thus enabling patients to carry out counseling along with physiotherapy over the phone via live sessions and maintaining follow-ups. 103 kids enrolled during the last 5 months of the lockdown and are taking benefit of Physiotherapy & Counseling on a daily basis.

NISARGA CYCLONE - SUPPORT TO 175 CHILDREN IN RAIGAD DISTRICT

FIL/MMF Supported Shikshangram Naisargik Shikshan Sanstha Home at Devale Malavli, Pune to reconstruct the roof destroyed by Cyclone Nisarga alongwith like minded donors Sanjiv Reena Aurora, Rohit Namita Pal and Kamlesh Nishita Shah. This institute houses 175 orphaned children single parent. These children are mostly abandoned. The roofing work is now complete.



NISARGA CYCLONE - SUPPORT TO 176 FAMILIES AND THEIR SCHOOL IN RATNAGIRI DISTRICT

FIL/MMF in continuation to its support to Nisarga cyclone affected homes and families, once again reached Dapoli and Mandangad in Ratnagiri and distributed 1650 steel sheets. In this relief work, we have helped fifty six families with 20 sheets each. Alongside a school "Samata Shikshan Sanstha" has been supported with 130 sheets. Total 176 families and a school have been supported in both the phases.

Our students along with the team of teachers worked hard on identifying and doing comparative studies on the topics - Wild animals from India and Thailand, family composition in India and Thailand. These studies were made with an intense mix of preparing charts, crafts, work sheets, clay models, Globe observations, street plays and collage making. A detailed dossier with all these details was prepared and submitted to British Council.

1. ASHADEEP - A HOME FOR THE CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEED- Pedestal fans and Kitchen stove were donated in order to keep the children comfortable and healthy. Total of 20 children have been benefitted with this donation. Since last 4 years, MMF has been supporting Ashadeep with monthly groceries.



2. TREE PLANTATION - To make students sensitive towards Environment Conservation, tree plantation activities were organized. The students of Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya planted tree saplings in the school premises and in FIL pipe yard.



3. RECOGNITION - The students of MMV were awarded certificates in order to recognize their contribution of planting trees as a step towards environment conservation. Parents of MMV students, FIL and MMF officials graced the event with their valuable presence.



4. ANANDI ASHRAM - Monthly grocery kits were distributed to help meet the food and nutrition needs of the 13 Senior ladies (Age 60-96 years) residing at this Ashram.
