Report on Progress in Completion of Basic Training course in Cutting & Tailoring and Sozni Embroidery.

Introduction:

Three months ago, HELP Foundation J&K, in collaboration with the Mukul Madhav Foundation & FINOLEX India, established two specialized skill development training centres in Beerwah, Budgam. These centres are imparting skill courses in Cutting and Tailoring and Sozni Training Centre, designed specifically for empowering young girls with vocational skills.



Objectives:

1. **Cutting and Tailoring Training Centre:** To equip participants with the skills necessary to design, cut, and tailor garments, providing them with a pathway to economic independence and self-employment.
2. **Sozni Training Centre:** To teach the traditional craft of Sozni embroidery, a renowned textile art form, fostering cultural heritage preservation and creating opportunities for income generation.

Training overview:

- **Duration:** 3 months
- **Participants:** Women/Girls from the local communities
- **No. of girls enrolled in Cutting & Tailoring course :**47
- **No. of girls enrolled in Sozni embroidery course:** 42

Curriculum:

Cutting and Tailoring: Basic garment cutting, pattern-making, fabric-selection, and stitching techniques.

Sozni Embroidery: Design patterns, embroidery techniques, and finishing skills.

Achievements:

1. Skill Acquisition:

- Participants have successfully completed their basic training, demonstrating proficiency in both cutting and tailoring as well as Sozni embroidery.
- They have created a variety of sample garments and embroidered pieces, showcasing their new skills.

2. Empowerment:

- The training has significantly boosted the confidence and self-reliance of the participants, preparing them for potential employment or entrepreneurial ventures.
- The trainees now possess valuable skills that can lead to self-employment opportunities or enhanced employability in the textile industry.

3. Community Impact:

- The training centres have provided a much-needed vocational skill set to the local community, contributing to economic development and women's empowerment in the region.



Next Steps:

- 1. Advanced Training:** Offer advanced modules or specializations to further enhance the skills of the participants and broaden their opportunities.

- 3. Community Outreach:** Extend training opportunities to more girls in the community and explore additional areas of vocational training based on demand.



4. **Assessment & Certification:** After successful completion HELP will organize the assessment & certification of the trainees through competent agency.
