Graduation Ceremony for Plumbing Students 25th November, 2024

FIL-MMF celebrated the graduation of 47 plumbing students, including three women, from Kendrapada ITI, Odisha. This initiative, launched in 2023, aims to bridge the skill gap in the region and empower youth with employable skills. The event marked a proud moment for the graduates, who received certificates and momentos to commemorate their achievements. Representatives from FIL-MMF and local dignitaries attended, underscoring the importance of vocational training in driving economic growth. This milestone reflects the success of public-private partnerships in fostering skill development and employment opportunities. Since 2022, FIL-MMF has supported 125 children with clubfoot by providing corrective treatments and medical care. Building on this success, they have committed to aiding an additional 145 children across Gujarat, Bangalore, Rajasthan, and Maharashtra. Representatives from FIL-MMF visited institutions to engage with families, doctors, and on-ground workers from Cure India. These interactions provided an opportunity to better understand the needs of children and ensure effective collaboration for their care.

Support for Children with Type-1 Diabetes 30th November 2024

Twenty-six children received insulin cartridges and essential lab tests, which are crucial for managing the condition effectively. This initiative began in 2016 through a partnership with KEM Hospital, Pune, and expanded in 2021 with the Diabetic Association of Baroda. Beyond providing medical aid, this year's camp included free health tests for parents, promoting holistic family health. A research study by KEM Hospital also added depth to the initiative, aiming to understand Type-1 diabetes characteristics in Indians.
